**2015/191** Minutes of the Annual Meeting held on Thursday 22nd May 2014 were circulated, confirmed and signed.

**2015/192 Chairman's Report:**

Cllr Frances Buckingham had started her term of office with the Public Enquiry drawing to a close. National Grid have proceeded with their plans for a pylon line which were outlined at a meeting with the Community Council in January. Now the Election is over perhaps the uncertainty will end. The traffic lights at Clapton Bridge were finally replaced – 12 months later only to be replaced with temporary lights at Newbridge. A temporary solution has been found with single file traffic over the Bridge but this is no long term solution. Problems also continue with the build out by City House and the height of the speed bumps. There has been a number of major planning applications with the proposed re-development of the Four Crosses Inn and the addition of 49 houses adjacent to Foxen Manor. Progress has been made with a circular walk, the addition of bench on Foxen Manor and two more purchased for the War Memorial site. Licence has now been granted to the Four Crosses Football Club for the use of the pitch and they are also to be congratulated on the refurbishment of the showers. Dog fouling remains a problem. Personal highlight was the commemoration of 100 years since World War I. Looking ahead the transfer of services from Powys County Council will present a challenge. She thanked all the fellow Councillors for all their work and paid special mention to Carol as Clerk Cllr Frances Buckingham was thanked on behalf of the Council by Cllr D K Evans and congratulated on the past year.
